A Pennsylvania man who heads a children's charity is saving lives in Vietnam by raising money for congenital heart surgeries. Paul's Kids has been an organized non-profit for about a year.

Since December 9th, life-saving congestive heart surgeries have been performed on children in Vietnam as a result of money raised by the organization. Surgeries children couldn't have otherwise because of the expense.
